The First University

A university is a place where people get an **education**, learn about different subjects, and help society by sharing knowledge. The oldest institution of this kind in the world is in Morocco. It was called the University of al-Qarawiyyin, and it was founded in 859 AD. A woman named Fatima al-Fihri started this university. At first, it was a big mosque where Muslims went to pray. Later, it became a place for academic learning, and it is still open today.

Today, there are more than 25,000 universities around the world. In Japan, the University of Tokyo and Kyoto University are considered the best in the country. Many students work hard to earn a **scholarship** to study at these top universities. Universities offer a wide range of **disciplines**, including science, engineering, humanities, and business.

Universities exist because people want to share knowledge and do **research**. Many countries believe that education can make society better. Since the first university was created, people have found ways to **cure** diseases, travel to space, and invent new technologies like the computer. Today, students attend **lectures** that help them prepare for the future. Fatima would probably be **proud**!
